Grade twelve students: Application Portals Open around Oct 1 or so for most Post-Secondary Institutions! See the post-secondary websites for details and remember to watch for deadlines! Apply early to colleges and to universities by the deadlines. Apply early to out of province institutions. Attend information sessions! Most BC post-secondary institutions now use <a href="EducationPlannerBC">EducationPlannerBC</a> (unless the post-secondary requires you to apply directly on their website e.g., BCIT). If so, you will be directed to make an <a href="EducationPlannerBC">EducationPlannerBC</a> account, select the post-secondary you wish to apply to, complete the application, and pay the application fee to submit your application. Sign back in to add more institutions. \*After you apply, check your post-secondary and email accounts often for communication, instructions, and deadlines!
