## Kol Nidrei (Judaism) September 24

Kol Nidrei occurs on the eve before Yom Kippur, a time of repentance and self-reflection.

#### Yom Kippur (Judaism) September 24-25

Yom Kippur is the holiest day in Judaism. It is the Day of Atonement when Jews ask forgiveness for their wrongdoings from their God and the people in their lives.

## Mawlid al-Nabi (Islam) September 26-27

Mawlid-al-Nabi is observes the day when the Islamic Prophet Muhammad was born.

## Sukkot (Judaism) September 29 – October 6

Sukkot one of the three major festivals in Judaism. It is a time of thanksgiving and a commemoration of the forty years during which the children of Israel wandered in the desert after leaving slavery in Egypt.
