Grade 9 Take Our Kids to Work Day

Core Competencies

CELEBRATING DIVERSITY

Musqueam Day November 1

November 1st is an important day recognized by Musqueam Nation to celebrate their ancestor's determination to seek justice and protect their inherent rights. On November 1, 1984, Musqueam won Guerin v. The Queen, the landmark Supreme Court of Canada case regarding the Shaughnessy Golf Course lease. The case, led by Musqueam Chief Delbert Guerin, fundamentally changed Canadian law.
