Did You Know?

The use of electronic cigarettes or e-cigarettes and vapour products equates to the act of 'vaping' and has seen an increased trend in secondary schools amongst districts in recent years.

In accordance to Section 2.2 of the Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act and School District policy (http://www.bclaws.ca/civix/document/id/complete/statreg/96451_01#section2.2), the use of tobacco or vapour products on school property is banned. The law includes requirements for retailers to ensure e-cigarettes and other vapour products are sold only to adults aged 19 and above and is treated no differently from the use of tobacco.
