The BC Excellence Scholarship is awarded to well-rounded high school graduates who have demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and who show aptitude for and commitment to their chosen career paths. Recipients receive a \$5000 scholarship voucher that they can redeem with the Ministry of Education after they are attending a designated post-secondary institution or a BC authorized trades training provider. The school may only nominate one candidate.

I have Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status
I am a BC resident
I am planning to study at a designated post-secondary institution (see <u>https://studentaidbc.ca/apply/designated</u> for designated schools).
