A reminder to grade eleven and twelve students and their parents to check the <u>Career Centre Website</u> <u>Calendar</u> often for date-specific information and Like and Follow <u>Ms. Millar's Career Centre Facebook</u> <u>Page</u> to receive notifications. See Post-Secondary Websites for the latest information and updates. There are many online/in-person information sessions for grades 10-12 students and their parents.

Grade twelve students: Post-secondary Application Portals are Open! See the post-secondary websites for details and remember to watch for deadlines! Apply early to colleges and to universities by the deadlines. Apply early to out of province institutions. Attend information sessions! Most BC post-secondary institutions now use <u>EducationPlannerBC</u> (unless the post-secondary requires you to apply directly on their website e.g., BCIT). If so, you will be directed to make an <u>EducationPlannerBC</u> account, select the post-secondary you wish to apply to, complete the application, and pay the Post-Secondary application fee, to submit your application. Sign back in to <u>EducationPlannerBC</u> to add more institutions. *After you apply, check your post-secondary and email accounts often for communication, instructions, and deadlines!

NOV 14/22 (noon) Queens Major Admissions Award In-School Deadline for Nomination Consideration

Students must be nominated for this award. Each school may nominate up to 2 or 3 students depending on their current grade 12 population. (Less than 250 - 1 nominee, 250-499 - 2 nominees, 500 or greater 3 nominees.) For school nomination consideration, be sure to see your In-school Scholarship Representative for instructions on how to submit a request for nomination form by the in-school deadline. Queens is looking for superior academic ability (high school grades 90%), creative and original thinking, and proven leadership qualities. In order to allow enough time to access the online Major Admission Award Application (MAA), out-of-province students should apply to Queens via OUAC no later than **Nov 20/22** to ensure you gain access to SOLUS to submit your MAA application by **Dec 8/22**.

Reference letter/s and an essay of up to 600 words, written by you, describing your community leadership experience is required.
