Grade twelve students: Post -Secondary Application Portals are Open! See the post-secondary websites for details and remember to watch for deadlines! Apply early to colleges and to universities by the deadlines. Apply early to out of province institutions. Most BC post-secondary institutions now use EducationPlannerBC (unless the post-secondary requires you to apply directly on their website e.g., BCIT). If so, you will be directed to make an EducationPlannerBC account, select the post-secondary you wish to apply to, complete the application, and pay the post-secondary application fee, to submit your application. Sign back in to EducationPlanner BC to add more institutions, and deadlines! Contact the institution directly if you have any questions regarding your application.

DEC 1/22 11:59 PM Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Deadline *Open to students of all abilities

To be considered for the Award, applicants must meet be: In good academic standing, Canadian citizens or landed immigrants, graduating from secondary school -Involved in voluntary humanitarian activities (for which they have not been compensated), planning to or are already studying towards a first university degree or diploma at a Canadian p/s institution. Award Recipients are eligible to receive the Award until they graduate with their first university degree or diploma (for a max of 4 years), provided they maintain satisfactory academic standing and a standard of humanitarian work and personal conduct which, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, justifies the award. The maximum value of the award is \$28,000, dispersed over four (4) years. A stipend of \$7,000 is issued directly to the institution each year in two instalments of \$3,500, one in Sept and one in Jan. For students who do not pay tuition fees, the award is \$3,500 per year, issued directly to the institution in two instalments of \$1,750 each. Recipients of the Terry Fox Humanitarian Award may not receive more than \$15,000 in total scholarships annually (including the Terry Fox Humanitarian Award). If a student's awards exceed this amount, any excess will be deducted from the student's Terry Fox Award: https://terryfoxawards.ca/applicant-information/
