See Post-Secondary Websites for the latest information and updates. There are many online/in-person information sessions for grades 10-12 students and their parents. Grade twelve students: Post -Secondary Application Portals are Open! See the post-secondary websites for details and watch for deadlines! Apply early to colleges and to universities by the deadlines. Apply early to out of province institutions. Most BC post-secondary institutions use [EducationPlannerBC](#) (unless the post-secondary requires you to apply directly on their website e.g., BCIT). If so, you will be directed to make an EducationPlannerBC account, select the post-secondary you wish to apply to, complete the application, and pay the post-secondary application fee to submit your application. Sign back in to add more institutions. *After you apply, check post-secondary and email accounts often for communication, instructions, and deadlines! Remember to complete the [BC Ministry of Education Student Transcript Services Form](#)/and also self-report marks if required so the institutions can access your marks/graduation. Contact the institution directly if you have any questions regarding your application.

JAN 31/23 David Lam/BC TEAL English Language Learner Scholarship Deadline to Apply

The scholarship is valued at up to \$3,000. It recognizes an English language learner graduating from a BC secondary school who has combined academic competence with school and community service, and who wishes to further his/her education at a post-secondary institution in British Columbia. Note that applicants for the David Lam/BC TEAL English Language Learner Scholarship must be documented permanent residents or citizens of Canada. International students on student visas are not eligible for this award.

The [CCOHS Council of Governors](#) established this scholarship fund in 2002 in the memory of Dick Martin, a tireless health and safety advocate and a pioneer of workplace health and safety in Canada. This \$3,000 national scholarship is available to any student enrolled, either full-time or part-time, in an occupational health and safety related course or program leading to an occupational health and safety certificate, diploma or degree at an accredited college or university in Canada. Programs include mine safety, occupational or industrial health and safety, industrial hygiene,

JAN 31/23 at 5 PM Langara International Entrance Awards Application Deadline

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be approved for admission to Langara as an international student (study permit holder).
- Have met all admission requirements and received an offer of admission.
- Intend to study full-time (nine or more credits) in a regular studies undergraduate program.
- Have IELTS 7.0 or equivalent. Please note, students who are residents and have completed formal education from English-speaking countries may be exempt from this requirement. Grades in English courses will be considered.
- Have a B+ average, equivalent to a GPA of 3.33 or 76% from their previous institution (high school or post-secondary). Please note, current high school students may submit their Grade 11 transcripts or interim Grade 12 transcripts for consideration. Kin Canada Bursaries was established in 1994 by Kin Canada as a legacy to its Founder, Harold Allin Rogers, O.C., O.B.E. (1899-1994) and is funded by Kinsmen and Kinettes across Canada. The program was established to encourage and sponsor educational programs, by providing financial assistance in the amount of \$1000 to successful applicants in their quest for higher learning at a recognized post-secondary. To be eligible you must:

Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

Plan to register as a full-time student in the 2023-2024 school year at a recognized post-secondary institution (e.g. University, College, Trade School, Technical Institute)

Demonstrate high ideals, community involvement and knowledge of Kin, and Not have previously received a Kin Canada Bursary. APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Complete all sections of the current application form. Applications will not be eligible if emailed or mailed directly to Kin Canada or if submitted more than once. FEB 1/23 Society of Manufacturing Engineers Scholarship Deadline

The SME Education Foundation inspires, prepares and supports the next generation of manufacturing and engineering talent through its Student Summit event series, SME PRIME® (Partnership Response In Manufacturing Education) initiative and Student Scholarship program. Basic criteria:

Must be a permanent resident or citizen of the United States or Canada.

Must have minimum of 2.0/4.0 GPA or higher.

Must be on a path toward an associate, bachelor's or graduate degree in manufacturing engineering, technology, or closely related field at an accredited college or university in the United States or Canada.

SME Education Foundation has awarded \$18 million to over 5,000 students since 2005. Graduating high school seniors as well as students pursuing two-year, four-year or graduate degrees in manufacturing or engineering are eligible to apply for scholarships. In the past two years, the Foundation awarded a record number of scholarships to women and minorities as part of a new [Diversity, Equity and Inclusion initiative](#).
