It is not a test for reading, writing or math. The MDI looks at children's points of view on: Social and Emotional Development, Connectedness, and Physical Health & Well-being.

Nirvana Day is a Mahayana Buddhist holiday celebrated in East Asia, Vietnam and the Philippines. By some it is celebrated on 8 February, but by most on the 15 February. In Bhutan, it is celebrated on the fifteenth day of the fourth month of the Bhutanese calendar.

<u>Maha Shivaratri</u>

Maha Shivaratri is a Hindu festival celebrated annually in honour of the god Shiva. The name also refers to the night when Shiva performs the heavenly dance called Tandava. In every month of the luni-solar Hindu calendar, there is a Shivaratri - "night of Shiva" - on the day before new moon.
