A reminder to grades eleven and twelve students and their parents to check the Career Centre Website Calendar often for date-specific information and Like and Follow Ms. Millar's Career Centre Facebook Page to receive notifications. See Post-Secondary Websites for the latest information and updates. There are many online/in-person information sessions for grades 10-12 students and their parents. Grade twelve students: Post-Secondary Application Portals are Open! See the post-secondary websites for details and watch for deadlines! Apply early to colleges and to universities by the deadlines. Apply early to out of province institutions. Most BC post-secondary institutions use [EducationPlannerBC](#) (unless the post-secondary requires you to apply directly on their website e.g., BCIT). If so, you will be directed to make an EducationPlannerBC account, select the post-secondary you wish to apply to, complete the application, and pay the post-secondary application fee to submit your application. Sign back in to add more institutions. *After you apply, check post-secondary and email accounts often for communication, instructions, and deadlines! Remember to complete the [BC Ministry of Education Student Transcript Services Form](#) and also self-report marks if required so the institutions can access your marks/graduation. Contact the institution directly if you have any questions regarding your application.

Are you a student graduating from a BC high school? Have you demonstrated a strong work ethic and tenacity in overcoming adversity and in achieving your goals? If so, we'd love to hear from you! Every year, we award up to 20 scholarships each with a max. value of \$40,000, paid over five years, to deserving students. In order to be eligible for a TCF Scholarship, applicants must:

Be a current resident of BC

Have lived in Canada for at least 7 years

Be in Grade 12 or a recent secondary school graduate

Have demonstrated financial need

Have faced adversity

Plan to be a full-time student

Be ineligible for the BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care)

Use funding for a post-secondary institution or college

Be endorsed by their school principal In-school deadline to request endorsement was Jan 23/23

Deadline for completed application to be submitted to Cmolik by student: FEB 7/23

FEB 7/23 McGill Major Entrance Scholarship Application Deadline

Value: \$3,000, \$5,000, \$10,000 or \$12,000. Major entrance scholarships are determined by selection committees and awarded on the basis of academic achievement and outstanding leadership in school or community activities. Emphasis is placed on academic excellence as the first priority, followed by demonstrated leadership. Note that "leadership" constitutes more than simple participation in extracurricular activities. A separate application is required that must be submitted after submitting your application for admission.
