March is Irish Heritage Month

In March, we recognize the important contributions that Irish-Canadians have made to building Canada, and to Canadian society in general.

Magha Puja Day (Buddhism) - Mar 6

Magha Puja is an important religious festival celebrated by Buddhists in Thailand, Cambodia, and Laos on the full moon day of the third lunar month.

Purim (Judaism) - Mar 6 to 7

Purim is a Jewish holiday which commemorates the saving of the Jewish people from Haman, an official of the Achaemenid Empire who was planning to have all of Persia's Jewish subjects killed, as recounted in the Book of Esther. Haman was the royal vizier to Persian king Ahasuerus.

Holi (Hinduism) - Mar 8

Holi celebrations start on the night before Holi. The next morning is Holi - the festival of colours, a festive day to meet and greet others and repair broken relationships. This also signifies the beginning of a good spring harvest season.

Hola Mohalla (Sikhism) - Mar 8 to 10

Festival for Sikhs to practice military exercises and follows Hindu festival of colours
