Passion Award Criteria:

The criteria for passion awards are set by each department and include qualities such as demonstrating a high level of interest; contributing positively to the class atmosphere and learning of others; and elevating the level of class discussion within the course. We believe passion for learning is the ingredient that inspires those that become great artists, great writers, great craftsmen, innovative inventors; groundbreaking scientists, business giants and social activists; inspiring musicians, athletes, and politicians. Passion for learning is the excitement and enthusiasm that motivates individuals to make a positive impact in the world.

Applied Design, Skills and Technologies:

- **Technology Education** The Technology Passion Award celebrates students who apply technological solutions to enhance their own lifelong learning. The award is presented to students who demonstrate enthusiasm, innovation, and commitment to personal growth, creativity, advocacy, collaboration, and sustainability efforts in Technology Education.
- Home Economics The Home Economics Passion Award honors students who show
 outstanding dedication to the subjects within Home Economics. The award focuses on their
 enthusiasm, innovation, and commitment to personal growth, creativity, advocacy,
 collaboration, and sustainability efforts in home economics education.

Art:

- The recipient of the Visual Arts Passion Award is honored for their unwavering curiosity in visual art and their wholehearted commitment to the creative process. They have exhibited remarkable initiative in exploring their creativity with various art materials, processes, and techniques. This student has shown a fearless approach to self-reflection and revision, constantly pushing the boundaries of their understanding of the visual arts while also encouraging other students with their positivity and knowledge.
- Performing Arts (Music) The Passion Award in Music is presented to students who
 demonstrate enthusiasm toward music learning and a keen desire to reach new heights in
 their musical knowledge and musicianship, often through independent exploration and
 study. These students also demonstrate a strong level of dedication and commitment to
 their ensemble and to the McRoberts Music community.



 Performing Arts (Drama) - The recipient of the Drama Passion Award is honoured for their commitment to the art of theatre creation, their emotional investment in the work, and their dedication to making the drama class a drama company. This individual sets a standard in terms of bringing a positive attitude and a commitment to developing excellent work whether it be on-stage, in class, or as a part of a group.

Business Education and Information Technology:

- Business Education The Business Education Passion Award is presented to a deserving student who has demonstrated a keen interest and knowledge in business, and who has worked extremely hard to do well on all assignments, always striving to improve their standards.
- **Information Technology -** The Information Technology Passion Award recognizes an inquiring mind, perseverance in problem solving and a desire to meet challenges.

English - The English Passion Award is presented to students that demonstrate a passion for the subject through their enthusiastic participation in class, their willingness to learn and improve over time through active reflection, and their encouragement of others' learning.

The recipient of this award is someone who inspires others and fosters a culture of mathematical excellence, encouraging a community of passionate learners who contribute to the advancement of mathematics.

Modern Languages – Recipients of the Modern Language Passion Awards consistently seek ways of improving oral, reading and writing skills; show keen interest towards the language and its culture; show a willingness to try new things; and show leadership skills in working with others.

Physical Health Education - The PHE passion award goes to students who enthusiastically engage in physical activities. These students consistently demonstrate exceptional effort, initiative, and cooperation.

Science - The Passion for Science Award is presented to students who actively engage in the scientific process and enjoy learning about science as a product of curiosity rather than as a



means of achieving good grades.

Social Studies - The Passion Award for Social Studies and Sciences Humaines is awarded to students who demonstrate a keen personal interest in the subject area through active engagement in class discussions by regularly connecting class topics to major historical and contemporary national and international events or figures, participation in social studies related clubs such as debate club and UN club, and active engagement in their communities.

We believe that recognition for achievement is for students who aspire to aim 'higher than the mark' for their learning.

 design and creative learning. Recipients also exhibit a capacity to assist others in their
 educational endeavors.

Art:

- Visual Arts The recipient of the Achievement Award in Visual Art is honored for their
 exceptional dedication, and creativity throughout the course. They've demonstrated
 extending artistic skill using various media and techniques, as they fearlessly explored new
 avenues of expression in both their visual journals and major assignments. Their work has
 consistently demonstrated a high level of sophistication, originality, and creative problemsolving. This award celebrates their remarkable achievements and overall growth as an
 artist.
- Performing Arts (Music) The Achievement Award in Music is presented to a student who
