<u>International Day for Abolition of Slavery – December 2nd</u>

Did you know that 10 million more people were in modern slavery in 2021 compared to 2016 global estimates and that the total number of people enslaved is currently about 50 million people worldwide? Women and children remain disproportionately vulnerable.

International Day of Persons with Disabilities - December 3rd

Promoted by the United Nations since 1992, this day is observed to b ring awareness to persons with disabilities.

National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women – December 6th

This day is in remembrance of the 14 young women at Polytechnique Montréal in 1989. It is a day to promote action to eliminate acts of violence against women, Wear white or orange to honour this day.
