

- 8. Fine Art, Applied skill / 2nd Language (elective for English program)

NOTE: grade 9 students are required to take 1 Fine Art and 1 Applied Skill elective. A language can be substituted for one of these.





Required Course Options – Math

- Depending on teacher recommendations, you may need to choose Math 9

GETTING THINGS DONE IN MYED

IMPORTANT! When all your course selections are correct hit the POST button on the bottom of the window.

Note: Failure to **POST** your course selections will impact the course registration totals and may cause a course to be dropped due to lack of enrollment. Each time you make a change after posting, you must hit post again for the system to pick up the changes.

PLEASE NOTE: you can go back into your account at any time during the Course Selection timeline (Feb14 - 28) to make changes and re-post your selection

(course selection window closes on Friday, February 28th @ 9am)

Make sure your selections in MyEd match the courses selected on your Course Selection Sheet!

If you make any changes in MyEd, make sure you also make those same changes on your paper sheet.
